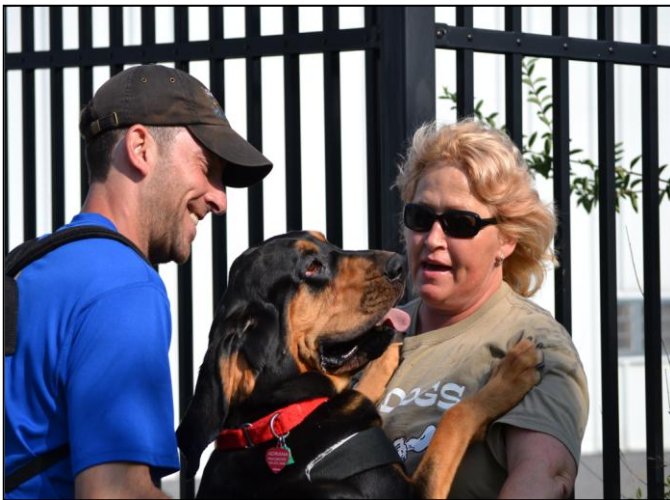

ABC TRAILING TRIAL RULES

All handlers are expected to be familiar with and to abide by the current ABC Trailing Trial Standard. Copies of the Standard can be obtained from any member of the Trailing Trial Committee, or can be downloaded from the ABC website at www.bloodhounds.org.

HOTEL

The newly renovated *Comfort Inn, 1601 Martinsburg Pike, Winchester, VA 22603, (540) 667-8894*, has a block of 20 rooms reserved under Colonial Bloodhound Club. Please let them know that you are with the CBC to get the special \$85.00 plus tax/ night rate. As a special courtesy, there is NO pet fee & NO pet deposit. Well behaved, crated dogs are allowed in the rooms. Please bring a plastic sheet to place underneath your crate(s). Each room is furnished with a microwave and a refrigerator. Please limit yourself to 1-2 dogs per room. The hotel provides guests a free hot breakfast each morning. *Hotel reservations should be made by March 15th.*

50/50 RAFFLE

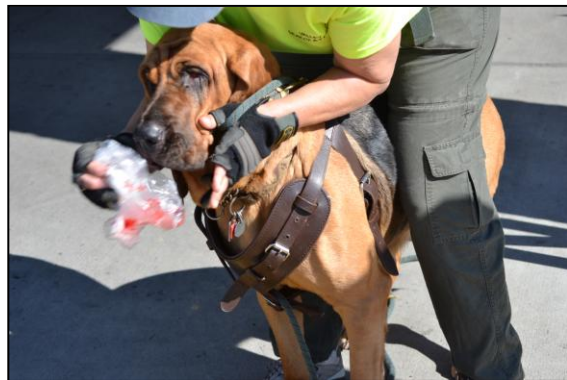

The MTX trails will be in urban areas with heavy contamination. Handlers please bring a safety vest to wear if you are running a MTX. A safety vest is provided for event judges.

Spectators are welcome at any and all events, so long as they do not interfere with the main focus of the trials themselves. Various sites in Winchester, VA and Frederick County, VA will be used for the two trials. Interested spectators should show up by 7:30am at the Comfort Inn, 1601 Martinsburg Pike, Winchester, VA on Saturday and Sunday. The sites for these two trials afford spectators a wonderful opportunity to watch the handler-dog teams in action. There should be ample opportunity to observe, ask questions, socialize and pet bloodhounds.
